

2016 **BIT** Summer **U**ndergraduate **R**esearch **E**xperience (**BIT SURE**)

Eligibility

To be eligible for this research experience, applicants must:

1. ...be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at NC State.
2. ...have completed BIT 410 by May 2016.
3. ...have available 25hrs each week from Monday, May 23rd – Monday, August 1st (10 weeks).
4. ...agree to present research as a poster at the NC State Undergraduate Research Summer Symposium. The Symposium date is Tuesday, August 2nd.

Support

Students will receive up to \$2500 to help support expenses. This will be paid as an hourly wage of \$10/hour for up to 25 hours per week. The total amount of compensation will depend on total hours worked, and may vary depending on project schedules.

- ___ Statement of purpose (Describe your career goals, what you would like to gain from this experience, and how being selected could help you achieve those goals. Please limit it to 2 typed, single-sided, double-spaced pages.)
- ___ 1 copy of undergraduate transcripts (unofficial transcripts will be accepted)
- ___ 2 letters of recommendation (excludes BIT 410 instructors) – must be sent by the referring individual (i.e. reference) directly to Dr. Thomas Lentz (tblentz@ncsu.edu)

All application materials must be submitted by **Friday, February 26th**.
